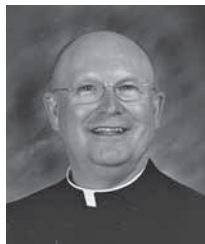

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION



Students in grades 2-12 can register Sunday, August 12 or August 19, 9:00am—2:00pm in McGovern Hall. Additionally, students in grades 2-5 can register in the parish office during regular office hours.

2nd—5th GRADE:

- ◆ **1st year First Reconciliation preparation—open to SECOND GRADERS.** *Birth certificate required for registration and copy of Baptism certificate if baptized at another parish.*
- ◆ **2nd year First Holy Communion preparation—open to THIRD GRADERS.** *Returning students only or transfers with official letter of first year completion.*
- ◆ **Continuing Formation Class—open to 4th & 5th graders** (not a sacrament preparation class)
- ◆ Classes will be held Wednesdays from 5:45—7:00pm

CONFIRMATION:

Confirmation preparation is a 2 year process. First year Confirmation students must be at least 14 years old. The Bishop confirms only those who are at least 16 years old. Bring Baptism and First Holy Communion certificates at time of registration. Classes are Sundays from 10:00am—12:20pm (followed by Mass at 12:30)

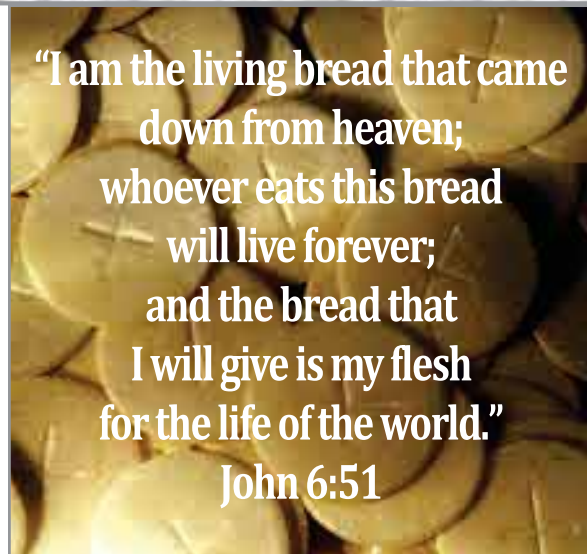
