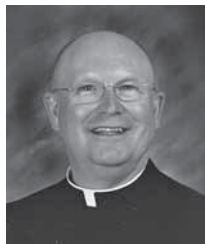

RELAX

God put the wiggle in children; don't feel that you must suppress it in God's house. They are welcome here.

SIT NEAR THE FRONT

Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what is going on at the Altar. They are tired of seeing the backs of others' heads. Quietly explain the parts of the Divine Liturgy, actions of the priest, deacon, altar servers, choir, etc.

SING

Sing the hymns, pray, make the Sign of the Cross. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.

DON'T WORRY

If you have to step out of the Church during the Divine Liturgy, feel free to do so, but please come back.
