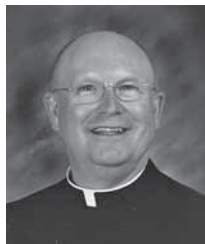

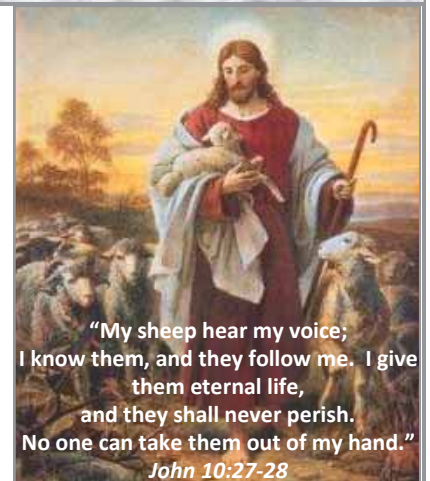

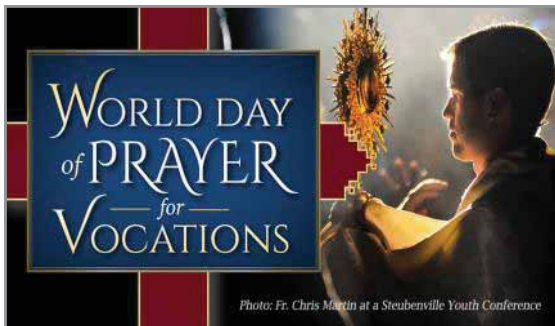

#### A PRAYER FOR OUR PRIESTS

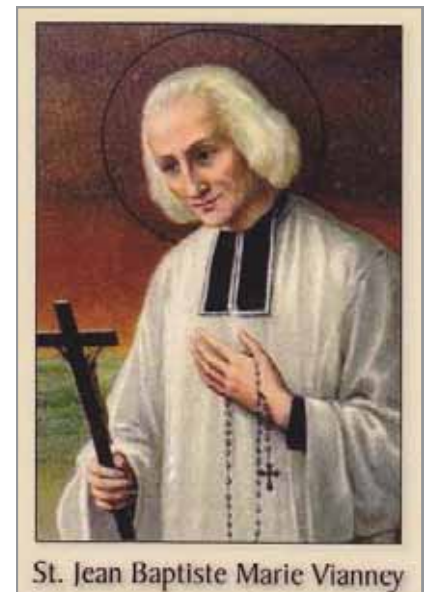

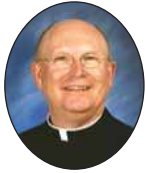
