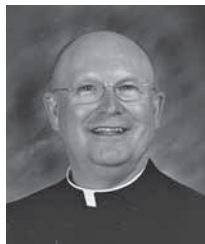

This feast of the Lord's Ascension historically was celebrated 40 days after Easter Sunday, always a Thursday of the week. Nevertheless in some parts of the Catholic world, the Ascension was transferred to the following Sunday as we do here in California. The local bishops hoped that the change of date would allow more of the faithful to celebrate this important feast on the weekend than during a week day. I believe that their decision has had their desired result. In the nations of the world, where there is a Catholic majority, the Church's holy days are also civil holidays. That not being the case so here in California, we now have Ascension Sunday rather than Ascension Thursday!

Remember that only a few years ago, in the island nation of Cuba, Christmas itself the 25 of December was not a civil holiday. Only papal persuasion got Christmas put back on the nation's calendar!

#### The Ascension of the Lord

St. Augustine

Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven; let our hearts ascend with him. Listen to the words of the Apostle: If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth. For just as he remained with us even after his ascension, so we too are already in heaven with him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies.

Why do we on earth not strive to find rest with him in heaven even now, through the faith, hope, and love that unites us to him? While in heaven he is also with us; and we while on earth are with him. He is here with us by his divinity, his power and his love. We cannot be in heaven, as he is on earth, by divinity, but in him, we can be there by love.

He did not leave heaven when he came down to us; nor did he withdraw from us when he went up again into heaven. The fact that he was in heaven even while he was on earth is borne out by his own statement:

**No one has ever ascended into heaven except the one who descended from heaven, the Son of Man, who is in heaven.**
