NOVEMBER: MONTH OF PRAYER FOR THE DEAD



1. DEATH

Death is the separation of a person's immortal soul from their mortal body.

2. JUDGEMENT

Judgement is when **the full account of one's life is assessed by God** to determine their final moral standing.

Everything we have done in this life will be accounted for before God. **This is why our choices on earth matter** as they will be the deciding factors of our fate.

3. HEAVEN

Heaven is the **eternal state of perfect happiness** from the face-to-face encounter with God.

4. HELL
