Feast Day of Saint Faustina Kowalska -October 5th

Today, October 5, is the feast of St. Faustina. She is considered the great messenger of Christ's Divine Mercy. She was the third born of ten children to a poor family in a small village in Poland. She only received three years of schooling but was raised in a family with deep and rich Catholic faith. She loved to pray, was pious and obedient, and was sensitive to human suffering. She was selected by Jesus to enter the convent and to write

what she was instructed (**-** mycatholic.life) —Those beautiful messages given to her by Jesus, Himself. She was the instrument God chose to write about his *UNFATHOMABLE MERCY!!* She wrote all these things down in her diary, which is now published in almost every language, "The Diary of St. Faustina." She was canonized by St. Pope John Paul II on April 30, 2000. During her life, she had visions of Jesus who shared with her that He wanted a picture painted in the image He showed her of Himself. Today this image is widely known as "The Divine Mercy" picture. In this picture Jesus is pulling back His garment to reveal His Sacred Heart with rays of red and blue light flowing forth from His heart. Those rays of light signify the blood and water which flowed forth from His most Sacred Heart when He gave His life by His suffering and death for all of mankind. That picture shows Jesus stepping forward towards the person who looks at it. His other hand is raised in blessing and the words underneath say, "Jesus, I Trust In You!" I'm sure you have all seen this picture. This holy image is a calling for all of us to Trust in Jesus and His Divine Mercy. St. Faustina once challenged Jesus with the question, of whether it is was easier for Him to be the Just Judge towards a sinner or to be Generously Merciful. She asked which was easier. Jesus conveyed to her that it was indeed easier for Him to shower souls with His Mercy and that was His desire....But that soul must be a trusting soul. So today, thank St. Faustina for being such an obedient instrument in Our Lord's hands. She is the one who truly spread the beauty and the mystery of God's unending and perfect Mercy towards us poor sinners. Take time and read the Diary. You will be truly blessed and glad that you did.

Pray the Rosary!

This coming **Tuesday**, October 7, is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary! It was known for centuries as the Feast of "Our Lady of Victory". In the year 1571 there was a great battle in Lepanto between European Christendom and the Ottoman Empire who was attempting to invade Europe. This was the day of victory, the battle was won! Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory at Lepanto — one of the most decisive in all of naval history— to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary through a campaign to pray the Rosary. Pope Pius V called for prayer and action. He pleaded with every man, woman, and child to pray the Rosary. It defeated the evil that was trying to take over the world and to crush Christianity. The Rosary is the most powerful prayer. It is sometimes referred to as Mary's Psalter or the Sword with which to fight and win battles against evil. It is "It has always been the habit of Catholics in danger and in troublous times to fly for refuge to Mary. This devotion, so great and so confident, to the august Queen of Heaven, has never shone forth with such brilliancy as when the militant Church of God has seemed to be endangered by the violence of heresy ... or by an intolerable moral corruption, or by the attacks of powerful enemies." (Pope Leo XIII) Our Lady at Fatima said, "I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue always to pray the Rosary every day." Our world today is facing great dangers that seek to destroy all that is good. I encourage all of you to pray the Rosary each day. Pray as a family or by yourself but use this as your sword that will defeat the powers of evil and defend you against the snares of the devil. No prayer, other than the Mass, is more powerful for the conversion of sinners and for bringing about good.
