Meaning and History of Third Sunday of Easter

The Third Sunday of Easter continues the joyful celebration of Christ's Resurrection. On this day, the Church reminds us that the miracle of the Resurrection is not a single event but a path for our everyday renewal. This Sunday invites us to deepen our trust in Jesus, who overcomes death and fills our lives with hope and grace. The faithful are called to reflect on their baptismal promises and to live with the light of His love, letting the joy of resurrection transform every act of daily life

The Third Sunday of Easter is an extension of the Easter celebration, inviting the faithful to bask in the warmth of the Resurrection. This day reminds us that the joy of Christ's victory over death is not confined to Easter Sunday alone but continues through out the Easter season. The liturgical celebrations are filled with hopeful hymns and readings that renew our commitment to living in the light of His resurrection.

This Sunday encourages the faithful to:

Recognize Jesus in daily life:

- The Gospel recounts the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus, who only recognize Jesus when He breaks bread, symbolizing His presence in the Eucharist

Renew hope and faith:

- The readings emphasize that Jesus' resurrection fulfills God's plan, offering courage and trust in His promises

Reflect on Baptismal promises:

- Catholics are invited to live in the light of Christ's resurrection, allowing the joy of Easter to transform everyday actions

What a *fantastic* night! Thanks to your incredible support, our Fish Fry was a huge success:

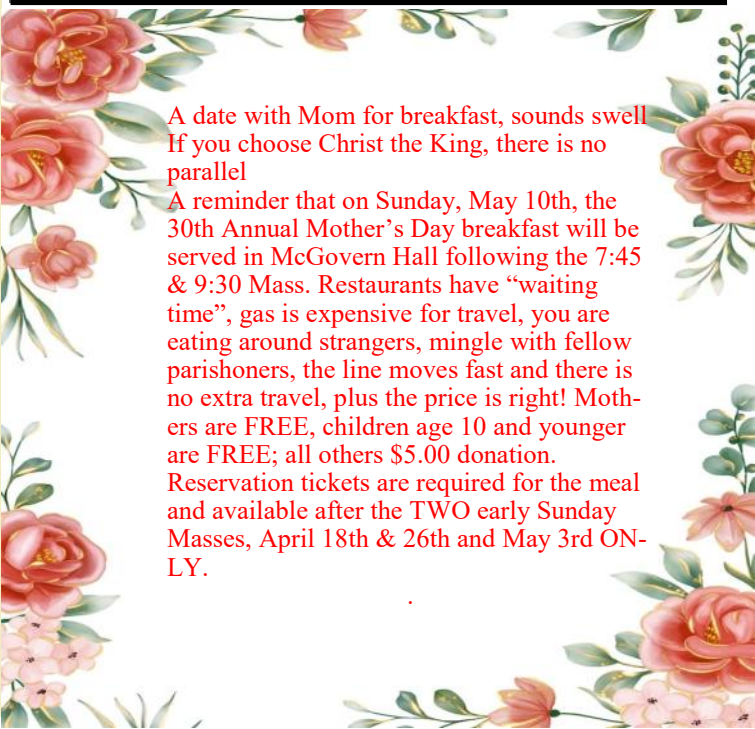
- **Net Proceeds: \$5,030.97**
